- 1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Welwyn Hatfield.

- 3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City AL8 6AE, between the hours of **10am to 4pm from Monday 3 June to Friday 7 June 2024**, but no later than **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.
- 4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom or electronic transfer of funds.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
- 7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, Room F6, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE by **5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. - 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, Room F6, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. New applications to vote by proxy at this election (not postal proxy or emergency proxies) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, Room F6, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. - 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity, for work/service reasons or attendance at a training or educational course must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, Room F6, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE by 5pm on Thursday 4 July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service or attendance at a training or educational course, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024.
