THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202X

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to create a new off street Order for the following car parks;

Aldbury Grove Car Park, Birchwood Leisure Centre Car Park, King George V Playing Fields Car Park, Longmead Car Park, Moneyhole Car Park, Prospect Place Car Park, Russett House Car Park and Thundridge Close Car Park

The new Order will allow Parking Services to introduce restrictions for electric vehicle charging points (Monday to Sunday 8am to 6pm 4 hours maximum stay, 4 hours no return) and to enable powers to enforce vehicles not parked within a marked bay.

It is intended these measures will:

- Provide electric vehicle charging facilities
- Reduce instances of inappropriate or obstructive parking

All the above restrictions have been subject to consultation with car park users, local businesses, the Police, Hertfordshire County Council and Borough and County Councillors representing the area.
