

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, HATFIELD SOUTH AND EAST, HATFIELD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMIT PARKING ZONES) ORDER 202X

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce resident permit parking zones and waiting restrictions in **Various Roads, Hatfield South and East, Hatfield**

Residents in the roads listed were consulted on proposed restrictions to address existing problems. Residents expressed concerns about local worker and commuter parking causing congestion; and vehicles parked too close to junctions.

The proposed restrictions are as follows:

Double yellow lines (No waiting at any time), affecting parts of

Allen Court, Ash Drive, Badger Way, Bishops Rise, Bradshaws, Brickfield, Bullens Green Lane, Bullrush Close, Chantry Lane, Cherry Way, Cloverland, Coney Close, Cooks Way, Coppice Close, Deerswood Avenue, Downsfield, Drakes Way, Far End, Foxglove Close, Furzen Crescent, Garden Avenue, Hamilton court, Hare Lane, High Dells, Hollyfield, Honeysuckle Gardens, Lamb Close, Millwards, Old Leys, Otter Gardens, Oxlease Drive, Primrose Close, Redhall Close, Redhall Drive, Richmond Court, Rycroft, Sandifield, Shallcross Crescent, St Audreys Close, Stanley Drive, Strawberry Field, Summerfield, The Pastures, Tollgate Road, Travellers Lane and Woods Avenue

Permit parking, Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm, permit holders only for Zone B21, affecting parts of

Oxlease Drive and The Pastures.

Permit parking, Monday-Friday, 8am-8pm, permit holders only for Zone B05, affecting parts of

Ash Drive, Bishops Rise, Bradshaws, Cherry Way, Coppice Close, Furzen Crescent, Garden Avenue, Hollyfield, Old Leys, Redhall Close, Redhall Drive, Shallcross Crescent and Summerfield.

Permit parking, Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm, permit holders only for Zone B30, affecting parts of

Travellers Lane.

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- **For the purposes of relieving or preventing congestion of traffic.**
- **For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.**

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. Hertfordshire Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Officers from Hertfordshire County Council, local residents and businesses have also been consulted.
