Parking consultation outcome – start of restrictions

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, SHERRARDS, WELWYN GARDEN CITY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING ON VERGE OR FOOTWAY) ORDER 2025

This letter is to update you on the parking consultation and upcoming parking restrictions in your road.

Following the Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel (CPPP)'s consideration of the scheme on 19 November 2024, the proposal was considered by the Council's Cabinet on Tuesday 7 January 2025 and made a recommendation to proceed with the proposed restrictions, with exception of Greenfield.

The Traffic Regulation Order has now been created and sealed to introduce the A18 resident permit zone in Densley Close, Reddings, Roundwood Drive and Sherrardspark Road, double yellow lines in the various roads within the Sherrards area as well as the Verge and Footway Prohibition Order.

The notice of making of Order will be advertised in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on 12 February 2025. Signage and lining installation works are underway and dependant on weather conditions.

The restrictions will come into effect on Monday 3 March 2025.

Permit zone

Zone A18 Monday to Friday 9am to 3pm Only residential properties in Densley Close, Reddings, Roundwood Drive and Sherrardspark Road would be eligible to buy resident permits and visitor vouchers.

Please note, residents in roads outside of the zone will not be eligible to purchase resident permits or visitor vouchers as per the published eligible address list.

Double yellow lines and verge and footway prohibition will apply 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

A permit/visitor voucher is only required if the vehicle is parking on the highway during restricted hours. Parking in garages or on private driveways off the road will not be subject to the parking restrictions. Permits do not allow parking on yellow lines or verges/footways.

The application process for permits is now open, please ensure you choose the start date on or after 3 March 2025.

You will need to create an account linked to an email address you can access for future permit renewal reminders, multiple applications for the same family household can be made through one account. You will be asked to upload the correct proofs either as a scan or a digital photograph and upload onto the account. To get started, once you have logged into the permit account, you do not need to click any other details on the screen apart from clicking on "Apply for a permit", where the whole process will be covered from uploading proofs, registering vehicle details and the permit cost applicable. Permit Costs (Valid until 31 March 2025)

Resident Permit 1st Permit £43 per year+
Resident Permit 2nd Permit £70 per year
Resident Permit 3rd or subsequent Permit £95 per year
Motorcycle Permit £23 per year
Visitor Vouchers (1-day vouchers) £21 for 20-day vouchers++
(limited to a maximum of 240-day vouchers in a 12-month period)
Admin charge for cancellation or change of details £11 per change.

- +Residents who are a Blue Badge holder will be eligible for 100% discount on the first household permit only upon proof of valid blue badge.
- ++Residents in receipt of state pension may buy vouchers at a 50% concession rate with proof of state pension for the address.

Review period

3 months after the restrictions have started, on 3 June 2025, a digital feedback form will be available on our website **www.welhat.gov.uk/parking-consultations** for residents to give further details on how the restrictions are performing and request any further required changes for us to consider in the roads listed. If you are unable to complete the online form, please complete the form at the reverse of this letter and return to the address shown at the top of this letter before 5 September 2025. Once the feedback period closes, we will review all comments made and consider any further remedial action.
