NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) has made the above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce restrictions in Various Roads, Hatfield as specified in the Schedules to this Notice. The Orders will come into effect on **19th of June 2023**

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Business Permit	£245 per annum
Visitor Voucher	£11 for 20 day vouchers or 50% discount to residents receiving state pension sold in whole books of Daily Vouchers only.
Doctors/ Health Visitor Permit	£24 per annum
Special Permit	Charged at council's discretion
