In the text supplied it is talking about the WGC Southern Outfall sewer and the Mimram Trunk sewer.

The reason I asked you the question about the Rye Meads Southern Outfall sewer was because it is not in the 2009 WCS.

As for the upgrades around WGC i would be interested to know those exact upgrade dates as the original WCS is a 2009/10 doc and I have emails from TW that no upgrades of the TW sewers have taken place since 2009.

To be clear on the notes from the meeting, GK said that an old 1990's doc had been carried over in to the 2009 WCS and this was the reason for the old information in the IDP's for the last 5 years.

The point being that it was the WCS carrying the statement of the;

'direct connection to the Southern Outfall sewer at Rye Meads' and on that he said it was a mistake.

As far as I can see, there is now No mistake and niether the IDP or the TW Position Statement can be updated.

If you do decide to update your notes, can you put in to context that it was the 1990's document that was carried over in to the 2009 WCS and which affected consecutive IDP's as the 2009 WCS included the reference;

"Thames Water have identified that to deliver growth around Welwyn Garden City and Hatfield it is likely that the following infrastructure and infrastructure upgrades will be required:

A new direct connection to the Southern Outfall Sewer at Rye Meads.
