6 EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND

The Council currently calls off the NHS Framework for IT Hardware. This framework is with the Dell Corporation Limited and allows a direct award against pre priced goods such as laptops and associated hardware.

This framework has provided good value for money and is considered to be the best value public sector framework for IT Hardware. A typical laptop is between 15% and 20% cheaper than the retail price.

The NHS Framework is still live and available to call off for a maximum period of 4 years.

The General Procurement Board considered this at their June meeting and unanimously agreed with the recommendation to continue with a direct award To Dell Corporation Limited under the NHS Framework

6.1 Legal Implications:

A calloff from the NHS Framework is compliant with the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 and the council's Contract Procedure Rules

The award of the contract award will not result in any increase to the agreed budget for the service
